Dispute: Claim of Employes:

- 1. That the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company violated Rules 3, 4-Section 1(a), 5 (a), 6 (a) and (b), and 7 (a) and (g) of the Communications Agreement effective August 1, 1977 when they denied Communications Maintainer R. K. Langford at North Little Rock, Arkansas the overtime provisions of the Agreement, i.e., four and one-half hours (4.5') at the overtime rate for work performed on a holiday and outside his bulletined hours 4:15 p.m. to 8:45 p.m., July 4, 1978, a holiday.
- 2. That, accordingly, the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company be ordered to compensate Communications Maintainer R. K. Langford four and one--half hours (4.5') at the overtime rate for July 4, 1978.

Statement:

The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in exparte form, hearing thereon was waived, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.
