 Hammons at Osawatomie, Kansas the overtime provisions of the Agreement,
 i.e. for work performed on Tuesday, July 4, 1978, a holiday.
- That, accordingly, the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company be ordered to compensate Communications Maintainer D. C. Hammons six and seven-tenths hours (6.7') at the overtime rate for Tuesday, July 4, 1978.
