- 1. That the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company violated Rules 3, 4 Section 1 (a), 5 (a), 6 (a) and (b), 7 (a), (d), and (g) of the Communications Agreement effective August 1, 1977 when they denied Communications Maintainer G. C. Burton at Atchison, Kansas the overtime provisions of the Agreement, i.e., for work performed on Thursday, November 23, 1978, a holiday.
- 2. That, accordingly, the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company be ordered to compensate Communications Maintainer G. C. Burton two and seven-tenths hours (2.7') at the overtime rate for Thursday, November 23, 1978.

Statement:

The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in exparte form, hearing thereon was waived, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.
