Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company violated Rules 3, 4 - Section 1 (a), 5 (a), 6 (a), and 7 (a), (d) and (g) of the Communications Agreement effective August 1, 1977 when they denied Communications Maintainer R. S. Breitenbach at Monroe, Louisiana the overtime provisions of the Agreement, i. e., four and one-half (4.5) hours at class 3 overtime for work performed outside his bulletined hours on Monday, February 12, 1979.
2. That, accordingly, the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company be ordered to compensate Communications Maintainer R. S. Breitenbach four and one-half hours (4.5') at class 3 overtime for February 12, 1979.

Statement:


