Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That the Southern Pacific Transportation Company (Texas and Louisiana Lines) did improperly remove Electrician T. G. Odell, from service on December 14, 1979, pending investigation which was held on December 18, 1979, which resulted in his dismissal from service on December 20, 1979.
2. That accordingly, the Southern Pacific Transportation Company (Texas and Louisiana Lines), be ordered to restore Electrician T. G. Odell to his former position with seniority rights unimpaired, compensated for all wages lost, plus holiday pay and be compensated for all fringe benefits of which he was deprived.

Statement:

The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, hearing thereon was waived, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employee that the case be withdrawn.


