2. That the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company be ordered to compensate Carmen J. B. Ladd, J. Wells, K. Daigrepont, L. Daenen, M. Juneau, T. P. Lemoine and C. R. Eli in the amount of four (4) hours at the punitive rate.

Statement:


