Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That the Kansas City Southern/Louisiana & Arkansas Railway Company violated Rules 24(a), 28(a), (1), 62, and 64 of the April 1, 1980 controlling Agreement when they allowed Laborer Odom to operate the overhead electric traveling crane - June 30, 1981, at Shreveport, Louisiana.
2. That, accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to compensate Electrician S.J. Lavery, claimant - who was available for call, four (4) hours at pro-rata rate for June 30, 1981.
