1. That the Louisville and Nashville Railroad Company improperly employed the use of an Outside Contractor, and three employees of the Midwest Commodities Company, to transfer large rolls of paper from Q.C. 75268 to SCL 79952 taking from 8:00 AM, until 3:30 PM, on October 30, 1981.
2. Accordingly, the Louisville and Nashville Railroad Company should be ordered to compensate Carman G. L. Snodgrass, B. S. Hutchinson and L. A. Whitsell seven (7) hours and thirty (30) minutes each at the time and one-half rate of pay.
