Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. Under the current Agreement, Machinist H. Galbreath, J. L. Caldwell, and T. W. Bunn were deprived of their rights and compensation when Carrier posted improper bulletin requiring them to work positions on line of road away from their home seniority point without reimbursement for expenses incurred thereto.

2. That accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to correct improper bulletin and reimburse Machinists Galbreath, Caldwell and Bunn for all expenses incurred as a result thereof.

STATEMENT:


