1. That the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company violated Rule 22 and Agreement of August 17, 1978 when they refused to transfer laid off Carmen M. Kallies, J. Garcia, J. Lozano, and J. Calamntz to vacant jobs at San Antonio, Texas.

2. That the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company be ordered to compensate Carmen M. Kallies, J. Garcia, J. Lozano, and J. Calamntz for eight (8) hours each per each working day, starting June 21, 1982 and continuing until violation is corrected.
