Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That the Grand Trunk Western Railroad Company be ordered to restore Machinist Trainee M. L. Holston to service and compensate him for all pay lost up to time of restoration to service at the prevailing Machinists' rate of pay.
2. That Machinist Trainee M. L. Holston be compensated for all insurance benefits, vacation benefits, holiday benefits, and any other benefits that may have accrued and were lost in this period and otherwise made whole for all losses in accord with the prevailing agreement dated September 1, 1949, as subsequently amended.

Statement:

The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, hearing thereon was waived, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the parties that the case be withdrawn.
