PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS
THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY SYSTEM

DISPUTE.—“That rate of pay of Agent at Madera, California, should be increased from 70¢ to 86¢ per hour.”

FINDINGS.—The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds that:

The dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board *ex parte by complainant party*.

Subsequently complainant party requested that hearing upon said dispute be deferred, and no hearing thereon has been had. Under date of March 15, 1935, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division containing the request “that this appeal be entirely withdrawn from consideration by your Board.”

AWARD

Case dismissed.
