DISPUTE.-

"Claim of Conductors C. M. Stone, R. E. Dooley, and J. E. Rauscher that they have been deprived of the seniority to which they are entitled by the allowance of seniority credit to Conductor F. B. Orvis while he was occupying a promoted position. They claim pay for time lost on account of the seniority inproperly allowed Conductor Orvis. They also ask that their seniority rights be restored."
