**PARTIES TO DISPUTE:**

**BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES  
SOUTHERN PACIFIC LINES IN TEXAS AND LOUISIANA**

**DISPUTE.—**

“Claim of employes that Bridge and Building Foreman Wm. Cox and two (2) Bridge Mechanics should be paid at the rate of time and one-half time for the full six-hour service performed by them on Washington's Birthday, February 22, 1936, and that this time and one-half time rate for such service is required under Article V, Section (a-5) and/or Article V, Section (a-9) of the current agreement.”

**FINDINGS.**—The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds that:  
The dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board **ex parte** by complainant party.

No hearing thereon has been had and under date of December 7, 1936, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing the case.

**AWARD**

Case dismissed.
