STATEMENT OF CLAIM.-

"Claim of E. E. Phares, A. F. Rountree, and D. E. Fread, employes at the Los Angeles Freight Station, Los Angeles, California, for compensation at the rate of time and one half for all time in excess of eight (8) hours from the time first required to report for duty to the time of final release, from November 22, 1935, to and including December 13, 1935."

FINDINGS.—The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds that: The dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party.

No hearing thereon has been held and under date of May 26, 1937, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of the case from further consideration, which request is hereby granted.
