STATEMENT OF CLAIM.—

"Claim for reinstatement of position of Cashier, rate \$140.00, office
of Freight Agent, East Moline, Ill., and reimbursement of monetary loss
sustained by employes account removing position of Cashier on Febru-
ary 18th, 1935, from jurisdiction of working rules agreement with Clerical
and Station Forces effective January 1st, 1931."

The dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board
jointly by the parties.
