STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of Mr. N. Mosier, employe in the office of Auditor Disbursements, Chicago, Ill., in the amount of \$11.50 for reimbursement of loss of overcoat and six keys from coat rack in the Rock Island General Accounting Office, Hamilton Park, Chicago, Ill., December 9, 1936."
