**BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS,  
FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES**

**LOUISIANA & ARKANSAS RAILWAY COMPANY**

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that—

"(a) The Carrier violated the wage agreement of April 1st, 1929, and current working agreement, when it paid Mr. E. A. Headrick, and others, Cashier, Hope, Arkansas, at rate of \$3.75 per day from October 14th, 1933, to October 31st, 1936, instead of \$5.14.

"(b) The Carrier shall now be required to compensate Mr. E. A. Headrick or any other employe who worked on this position during period stated, for all wage loss suffered as a result of Carrier's violation of our wage agreement between October 14th, 1933 and October 31st, 1936."

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the carrier and the employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing has been had and under date of November 16, 1939, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

**AWARD**

Case dismissed.
