**BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS,  
FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES**

**THE TEXAS MEXICAN RAILWAY COMPANY**

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes that Cashier R. L. Hinnant, Alice, Texas, shall be paid a minimum day of 8 hours at rate of time and one-half for each Sunday and holiday worked retroactive to September 16, 1938."

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party;

That no hearing thereon has been had, and under date of November 20, 1939, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

**AWARD**

Case dismissed.
