**BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS,
FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES**

THE TEXAS MEXICAN RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

"1. The position of Messenger at Agua Dulce, Texas be classified as a clerk with a rate of \$135.00 per month retroactive to September 15, 1938; and

"2. That all employes involved in, or affected by the improper classification be compensated for all monetary loss sustained."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party;

That no hearing thereon has been had, and under date of November 20, 1939, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

Case dismissed.
