**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** "Claim of Harry Jaeger, Dining Car Steward, First District, that he be restored to the service with full seniority rights and reimbursed for all time lost since September 6, 1939."

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board *ex parte* by the complainant party;

That no hearing thereon has been had and under date of February 4, 1941 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.
