PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY (PACIFIC LINES)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Southern Pacific Company, Pacific Lines, that Telegrapher U. H. Pierce be compensated under the provisions of Rule 10 of the Agreement in effect between the parties to this dispute for the entire period of time, March 4th to 24th, inclusive, 1938, that he was used at Ravenna, San Joaquin Division."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That this dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been had, and under date of February 11, 1941, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.
