SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY (PACIFIC LINES)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that, positions now classified as Truck Lift Operators and compensated at rate of 62ϕ per hour in Stores Department of the Carrier at Sacramento, California, be reclassified as Car Loader Operators and given rate of $67\frac{1}{2}\phi$ per hour, retroactive to April 16, 1940."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That this dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of January 7, 1942, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
