Vaughn for 12 hours and 35 minutes on account of being taken out of their regular assigned schedule at Chicago on July 6th, 1939 and held for protecting.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and
