# NATIONAL RAILROAD ADJUSTMENT BOARD THIRD DIVISION

### PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

### HOUSTON BELT & TERMINAL RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (a) The Carrier is violating the Clerks' Agreement by requiring Record Clerks to perform work of the Interchange Clerk. Also
- (b) Claim that the First Record Clerk be paid an additional 84¢ per day, and the Third Record Clerk an additional 88¢ per day, retroactive to the date the interchange work was assigned to their positions. Also
- (c) Claim that the Interchange Clerk be paid eight (8) hours at the rate of time and one-half for each Sunday and holiday retroactive to May 16, 1941.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of August 20, 1942, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this dispute, which request is hereby granted.

### AWARD

Case dismissed.
