STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Violation of Rule 2 (e) of an existing agreement in furloughing of Usher John Marshall employed in the Jackson Mississippi Terminal.

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of September 24, 1942 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.
