PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

JOINT COUNCIL DINING CAR EMPLOYEES

THE ALTON RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the Joint Council Dining Car Employees Local 351, for and in behalf of Mr. Robert Roberts—for time earned on the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad—together with any other time earned by Mr. Robert Roberts while an employe on the Alton Railroad and used on the B. & O. Railroad, together with any and all time that may have been earned by any and all Alton Dining Car Employees on the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad from May 4, 1939 the date dispute was first called to Management's attention, and

That wherever and whenever any regularly assigned Alton Employee has been used under instructions of the Company, on the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad, each and every one shall be paid in each instance their full monthly guaranteed rate of pay on the Alton Railroad—plus all time earned on the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That hearing thereon has been held but not concluded. Under date of February 22, 1943 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
