**PARTIES TO DISPUTE:**

**BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS,  
FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES**

**GREAT NORTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY**

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** Claim of System Committee of the Brotherhood that Material Handlers at Whitefish, Montana, shall be paid at the rate of 64¢ per hour from April 1, 1941 to August 31, 1941, and at the rate of 73¢ per hour from September 1 to November 30, 1941, and at the rate of 74¢ per hour from December 1, 1941.

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of February 10, 1943 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.

**AWARD**

Case dismissed.
