**PARTIES TO DISPUTE:**

**BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYEES**

**MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY**

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood—

(a) That J. H. Pyle, B. & B. Foreman, Omaha Division, was unjustly dismissed from the service of the Carrier on October 17, 1942; and

(b) That J. H. Pyle be reinstated with seniority unimpaired and paid for all time lost from the date of his dismissal until he is returned to service.

**FINDINGS** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of July 19, 1943, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

**AWARD**

Case dismissed.
