O. R. C.—PULLMAN SYSTEM

THE PULLMAN COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Conductor E. F. Snead, Pennsylvania Terminal District, claims additional pay for work performed in the month of June, 1942, said work being special service trips June 15-18 and 18-21, which have been improperly paid for under Rule 8, Agreement between The Pullman Company and Conductors in the service of the Pullman Company.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of September 9, 1943, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
