STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Conductor W. B. Jones, Baltimore District, claims additional pay for work performed in the month of August, 1942, being special trip from Ft. George Meade, Maryland, to Camp Wallace, Texas, August 22-26, this trip having been improperly paid for under the terms of Rule 8, Agreement between The Pullman Company and Conductors in the service of The Pullman Company.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of November 8, 1943, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case which request is hereby granted.

Case dismissed.
