PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILROAD SIGNALMEN OF AMERICA
SOUTHERN PACIFIC LINES IN TEXAS AND LOUISIANA

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: That Frank Rigdon, signal helper, should have been assigned to position of assistant signalman September 2, 1942, and shall be paid the difference between the rate of signal helper and that of assistant signalman from the above date to date he left the service of this carrier.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of Nov. 15, 1943, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing the case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
