THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on The Pennsylvania Railroad, that Operator L. D. Kerr, required to work assigned relief day April 10, 1942, second trick "A" Office; and Thomas Eddy, required to work his assigned relief day on April 19th, 1942, third trick "A" Office, Erie, Pa., are entitled to time and one-half under the provisions of Regulation 4-B-4.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of February 7, 1944, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
