## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES COLUMBUS AND GREENVILLE RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood—

- (1) That the Carrier violated the provision of the agreement when it failed to bulletin the position of Foreman as provided in Rule 20; and
- (2) That Sam Ray be paid the difference between Section Foreman's rate received and the rate of Extra Gang Foreman from July 1, 1942 continuing for the period the position was filled without bulletin and proper assignment as provided in Rule 20.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of February 17, 1944, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.

## AWARD

Claim dismissed.
