PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES
THE GEORGIA RAILROAD

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that yard section foreman N. L. Capps, who was erroneously displaced as yard section foreman on Section No. 1, Augusta, Georgia, on April 17, 1944, shall be paid for time lost in an amount equal to that which he would have earned as yard section foreman on Section No. 1, Augusta, Georgia, from April 17th to July 13, 1944 inclusive.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of November 30, 1944, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.
