STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes, that Timekeepers and others employed in Division Auditor Offices at Tampa and Jacksonville, Fla., and Raleigh and Hamlet, N. C., be paid four (4) hours overtime for work performed Saturday afternoon June 19, 1943.

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and
