STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood-

- 1.—That the Carrier violated provisions of the Clerks' Agreement when it declined to assign Mr. J. F. Kimble to position of Assistant Car Distributor as advertised on Wheeling Division Advertisement No. 14 on April 11, 1942.
- 2.—That Mr. J. F. Kimble be paid for wage loss suffered by him for all time worked after April 21, 1942.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board jointly by the parties;

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of August 21, 1945, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of the case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
