STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of the Order of Railroad Telegraphers in Missouri Pacific Lines in Texas and Louisiana that E. A. Kurtzman, Agent Telegrapher be reimbursed in the amount of \$26,50 which represents the amount he is outstanding account not being transferred to Temporary position of agent at LaPryor, Texas.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and
