BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE TEXAS MEXICAN RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brother-hood that:

- (a) The carrier be required to reinstate Mr. Alex Saenz to the position of Cashier at Laredo, Texas, with seniority rights unimpaired; also
- (b) Claim that the carrier be required to pay Mr. Saenz the full amount he would have been paid had he not been removed from service.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of December 18, 1945, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of the case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
