STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes on the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company that the Carrier violated the Clerks' Agreement:

- 1. When on November 12th to 19th inclusive, 1944, it failed and refused to release Clerk H. C. Housley from position of Yard Clerk, Van Buren, Ark., rate \$6.56 per day, hours 4:00 P. M. to 12:00 midnight, and permit him to go to his regular assigned position of yard clerk at Ft. Smith, Ark., rate \$6.41 per day, hours 8:00 A. M. to 12:00 noon—1:00 P. M. to 5:00 P. M., six days per week, to which position he was assigned on November 11th, 1944, per Superintendent's Bulletin No. 88-A dated November 11th, 1944, but instead held him at Van Buren, Ark. and required him to work 4:00 P. M. to 12:00 midnight on each of the dates shown.
- 2. That Clerk H. C. Housley shall be compensated the difference in amount of \$55.76 paid him by the Carrier and the amount he should have been paid:

  - (b). Eight hours at pro rata rate of \$6.41 per day of the regular assignment at Ft. Smith, Ark., less one hour, (period 4:00 P. M., to 5:00 P. M.—amount 80¢) for Monday, November 13th; Tuesday, November 14th; Wednesday, November 15th; Thursday, November 16th; Friday, November 17th and Saturday November 18th...\$33.60

NOTE: Eight hours at pro rata rate of \$6.41 for his regular assignment at Ft. Smith, Ark., 8:00 A. M. to 12:00 noon—1:00 P. M. to 5:00 P. M., less one hour (period 4:00 P. M. to 5:00 P. M., or 80¢) reducing the net amount which is due him for each such days in this phase of the claim to \$5.60 per day account working during that hour at Van Buren as result of the Carrier's action in holding him off his regular assigned position and prohibiting him from working same. That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of March 15, 1946, the parties jointly advised the Secretary of the Third Division of their desire to withdraw it from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

#### AWARD

Case dismissed.
