**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** Claim of the General Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes on the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railroad, that

- (1) The correct rate of pay for the position of Stenographer Clerk in the City Ticket Office, Kansas City, Missouri, is \$168.96, retroactive to the date the position was created.
- (2) Claim that employes involved in or affected by the agreement violation be compensated for all losses sustained.

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of May 10, 1946, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

**AWARD**

Case dismissed.
