PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS LEHIGH VALLEY RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on Lehigh Valley Railroad, that:

- The Carrier acted capriciously and arbitrarily when, on April 3, 1945, it disciplined Towerman-Telegrapher P. M. Anthony, regularly employed at the Lehighton Tower, by placing twenty (20) demerits against his service record for alleged misrouting freight Extra 493 West from main track No. 1 to Yard Track No. 5 instead of Yard Track No. 9 in the Packerton westbound freight yard on the night of March 18-19, 1945, and
- that, since Anthony was not proved guilty of the offense as charged the discipline administered against his service record shall be removed and his service record cleared of the charge.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of ,the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant pary; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of August 5, 1946, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
