STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (a) The Carrier violated agreement and settlement with the Clerks' Organization effective September 19, 1944 when it removed a part of the work of handling mail and baggage at Troup, Texas, from the scope and operation of the Clerks' Agreement. Also
- (b) Claim that the Porter at Troup, Texas, be reimbursed for all losses sustained because of the violation.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of October 31, 1946, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
