PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

JOINT COUNCIL DINING CAR EMPLOYES, LOCAL 370

PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the Joint Council Dining Car Employees, Local 370, on the property of the Pennsylvania Railroad Company, for and in behalf of Chef M. O. Joseph, Chicago District, for compensation at the 4th Cook's rate, in addition to the earnings of his regular position as Chef, as a result of his being required to perform the duties of a 4th Cook in addition to his own duties as Chef on Train 78, February 1st, 1945.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of May 21, 1947, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.
