PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE TEXAS MEXICAN RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (a) The Carrier violated the Clerks' agreement when it discharged Mr. R. J. Notzon, Storekeeper at Laredo, Texas, on the basis of charges that were not sustained. Also
- (b) Claim that Mr. Notzon be reinstated to his former position with seniority rights unimpaired. And
- (c) Claim that Mr. Notzon be compensated at the regular rate of his position for each day he is illegally withheld from service.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of July 27, 1948, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
