STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of Joint Council Dining Car Employes, Local 351, on the property of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad Company, for and in behalf of Mr. Booker T. Turner, dining car waiter to be reimbursed for net wage loss as a result of being withheld from service and from payroll of the Carrier for Thirty (30) days beginning September 11, 1948, said discipline being imposed in violation of Article VI, Sections 1 and 4, and in abuse of discretion by the Carrier.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of April 30, 1949, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.
