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**PARTIES TO DISPUTE:**

**UNITED RAILROAD WORKERS OF AMERICA (CIO)**

**ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY  
COMPANY—EASTERN LINES**

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** (1) That the Carrier violated the agreement by laying off entire Section Gangs on the Missouri Division for a short period between January 13 and 17, 1949.

(2) That certain named employees be paid for all time lost.

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of October 4, 1951, the duly authorized representative of the Employees addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case for reasons explained, which request is hereby granted.

**AWARD**

Case dismissed.
