NATIONAL RAILROAD ADJUSTMENT BOARD

PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES
CENTRAL OF GEORGIA RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood:

(1) That the Carrier violated the provisions of the effective agreement when it released Mr. O. R. Holley from his official position as Track Supervisor with headquarters at Leeds, Alabama, and permitted him to displace a regularly assigned Section Foreman on the Columbus Division without terminating the official position of Track Supervisor at Leeds, Alabama;

(2) That Mr. O. R. Holley be restored to the official position of Track Supervisor with headquarters at Leeds, Alabama;

(3) That all employees who were displaced as a result of the Violation referred to in Part (1) of this claim, be restored to their former position;

(4) That all adversely affected employees be reimbursed for any monetary loss incurred.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of February 21, 1952, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
