BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (a) The Carrier violated the provisions of the Rules Agreement, effective May 1, 1942, as amended, particularly Rules 4-A-2(c) and 4-C-1, by not permitting Olive D. Richardson, Telephone Operator, Telephone Exchange, Altoona Works, Altoona, Pennsylvania, to work her regular position as Telephone Operator on February 23, 1950.
- (b) Olive D. Richardson, Telephone Operator, be compensated for eight hours at one and one-half times her regular rate. (Docket A-77.)

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of May 29, 1952, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
