PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE WICHITA UNION TERMINAL RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: (a) Carrier violated rules of the Clerks' Agreement at the Wichita Union Terminal Railway Company, Wichita, Kansas, when on July 13, 1952, it used a junior employe to fill a vacancy in preference to a senior qualified and available employe; and

(b) Orville W. Inde shall now be paid for eight (8) hours at the rate of time and one-half of Position No. 121 for July 13, 1952, as result of this violation.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of December 7, 1953, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
